# **Public Speaking**

A request was made for a breakdown of the costs for the grass cutting and recent hedge trimming, this was provided. Confirmation that a Complaint form had been received was requested, The Clerk advised that the form had been sent to the Monitoring Officer at Tendring District Council. Another member of the public talked about past conditions at the cemetery. At this point several members of the public became very aggressive towards the Councilors with one being threatened with violence. The Chairman moved to have this person excluded from the meeting, but they refused to leave. The police were then called. A request for calm was ignored so the meeting was suspended, and members of the public asked to leave (Standing Orders Section 2 (a), (b) and (c). Members of the public refused to vacate the building only doing so when ordered to by the police.

## **Clerks Report**

**Storage and GDPC Audit** – EWD have quoted a starting cost of £5 per bag minimum order of 10 then afterwards £5 per any additional bag. The bags are secure and collected by EWD.

**Dog Bin emptying invoice** – TDC were phoned and a voice mail left. The previous invoice was dated May 2018. TDC have not yet replied.

**Gyro Seat and Zip Wire spares** – have arrived and NGF confirmed that the chain may need cutting to fit.

**Recycling bins** – these have been reported. TDC have contacted the contractors and requested that the bins be emptied.

**Road Markings** – an email has been received asking if the white lines from The Village Maid down towards the Strangers could be re-painted as they have faded which could lead to traffic problems.

**A120 Closures** – an email has been received regarding the diversion routes. Concerns were raised about the extra traffic travelling through the village at speed and the amount of HGV vehicles travelling in both directions causing problems when trying to pass each other. The resident would like to know what measures the Parish Council have taken.

**Resignation of the Handyman Contractor** – this was received 15<sup>th</sup> October and an acknowledgement email sent on behalf of the Parish Council.

The bolt on the gate to the small children's play area is not closing, the gate appears to have dropped. Some fence panels around this area have a slight amount of movement. One post has been cracked but is still in place. The picnic benches can be lifted slightly on one side and the bench near to the village sign has a crack where is has been caught exposing some of the wood.
