Dear Parents and Guardians,

I hope everybody had a relaxing half term. With 7 weeks of school and club gone by so quickly, I just wanted to say a big thank you for your understanding and patience. From having to change our collection time and pick up time to more cleaning in session. I am thankful to the school for allowing Superkids to run a service as I understand a great many schools have closed their wraparound care. With this term going very quickly, I just wanted to remind parents of the changes we have made. In this updated newsletter, I have parent reminders for pick up and drop off times. Please make sure everybody who drops off or collects your child is aware of these times, thank you.

Drop off time reminders

For breakfast club: our drop off times are **7:30**, **7:45** and the last time to drop off is **8am**, thank you.

The school have asked parents not to press the buzzer. We will come to you at the above times. Thank you.

Collection time reminders

We have one early collection time, which is at **4pm**. Please text us on 07787 734 432 if you are collecting early so your child is ready.

There are no collections between 4 and 5pm

The next collection time is **5pm**, then **10 minutes thereafter**. We will come to the gate, no need to call when collections plunge into darkness.

The school have asked parents not to press the buzzer. We will come to you on the above times. Thank you.

Keynote: Superkids team will start cleaning their hub areas and equipment from 5:30pm. Where possible, please collect by this time. If not, we understand you still need to work and travel.

Breakfast and After School Club service during national lockdown from 5th Nov.

It is our intention to continue the breakfast and after school service at the normal start and finish times throughout the planned national lockdown commencing 5th November.

This is possible if we can maintain a viable service which means children's continued attendance is vital to our sustainability. Thank you and stay safe.

Extended learning

Just a quick side note. With us now working in year groups, we have had a great opportunity to carry on with extended learning for children inside hubs. From reception class learning Autumn to year 4's Ancient Egypt, it has been a nice to see the children actively engaging in activities.

How are we keeping the risk of Covid low?

See below our key points to help reduce the risk of transmutations between you, us and the children.

1. Hand washing before they go into hubs and washing hands when leaving school.
2. Children will remain with their own year group hubs, as they do during the school day.
3. Breakfast and snack will be provided inside the hall on disposable bowls / plates.
4. Where possible, one team member is allocated per hub, with an overseer for some hubs.
5. The team will start clean equipment from 5:30 everyday.
6. Hubs will have set equipment and the team will not share resources where possible.
7. The outside spaces will be used as best a possible (It is important for parents to notify us by text if they are collecting at 4pm)
8. We have reduced the size of the club to 60 children so we can socially distance hubs.
