SIZE

Adult M/L - 19in (48cm) circumference; stretches to at least 23in (58.5cm)

MATERIALS

Manos del Uruguay SERPENTINA (100% superwash Merino wool), approx. 130m/142yds per 100g, 1 hank
Shown in #P1276 Rigoberta Menchú (see Note)
Set of 4.5mm (US 7) double-pointed needles and a 4.5mm (US 7) 16in circular needles, or size needed to obtain correct tension
6 ring markers, one a unique colour
Tapestry needle

TENSION

15 sts and 24 rounds in a 10cm (4in) square over stocking stitch, using 4.5mm needles.

NOTE

To make the pompom on the hat shown, you can add remnants of a contrasting colour.

ABBREVIATIONS

Approx: approximately
Beg: beginning
CO: cast on
Dpn(s): double pointed needle(s)
K: knit
Kfb: knit into front and back of next st (1 st increased)
Ndl(s): Needle(s)
P: purl
Pm: place marker
Rep: repeat
Rnd(s): round(s)
Slm: slip marker
St(s): stitch(es)

INSTRUCTIONS

Using dpns, CO 6 st. Join to work in the round, being careful not to twist, and pm of unique colour to show beg of rnd.

Rnd 1: (Kfb) 6 times. (12 sts)

Rnd 2: *K1, kfb; rep from * to end of rnd. (18 sts)

Rnd 3: *K2, kfb; rep from * to end of rnd. (24 sts)

Rnd 4: *K3, kfb, pm; rep from * to end of rnd. (30 sts)

Rnd 5: Knit.

Rnd 6: *K to st before m, kfb, slm; rep from * to end of rnd. (36 sts)

Rep Rnds 5 & 6, twice more. (48 sts)

Note: Change to circular ndl when it becomes convenient.

Rnd 11: Purl.

Rnd 12: *K to st before m, kfb, slm; rep from * to end of rnd. (54 sts)

Rep Rnds 11 & 12, twice more. (66 sts)

Rep Rnds 5 & 6, once more. (72 sts)

Proceed with pattern, removing all markers except the beg-of-rnd marker.

Rnds 19-21: Knit.

Rnd 22: Purl.

Rep Rnds 21 & 22, twice more.

Rnds 27-31: Knit.

Repeat Rnds 21 & 22, 3 times more.

Rnds 38-43: Knit.

BRIM

Rnd 44: (P2, k2) to the end.

Last round forms rib. Repeat Rnd 44 until brim measures 4in (10cm) - approx. 24 rounds. Cast off in rib.

FINISHING

Make a 3in (7.5cm) pompom using remainder of yarn, or use contrast yarn (see Note), and attach to hat.

Weave in ends; block if desired.
