### **Directions to the Venue:**

NHDTC is based in the North Manchester area near to Oldham just off Junction 22 of the M60. Once off the motorway, take the A62 towards Manchester. At the second set of traffic lights turn right into Wickentree Lane (look for the Housing Units sign). Go past Housing Units on the right. Carry on for about another 100 metres and you will go past a pub called the Anglers Arms. About 15 metres after

the pub take the lane off to the right which goes under a railway bridge. Follow the lane round to the left and the club is in front of you.

### ***Description of Classes:***

**Steeplechase** – A straight forward flowing course with jumps and tunnels.

**Double Dog Walk**-A course where the only piece of contact equipment used is the dog walk of which you have to complete 2 times .(Also this class will be run as all heights, ie large, standard, medium, small, together)

Veterans	For dogs over 9 years old and over	
Anysize	For dogs that do not run at their designated height for various reasons	

There is an overlap between Starters and intermediate for Grade 3 dogs, this is particularly aimed at new dogs starting to compete where their handler is Grade 3 at KC shows and the dog needs slightly easier courses.

<b><i>Dog Heights (UKA and KC Measurements accepted)</i></b>		<b><i>Jump Heights</i></b>
<b><i>Micro</i></b>	For dogs under 14" at the withers	25cm
<b><i>Small:</i></b>	For dogs under 16" at the withers	35cm
<b><i>Medium:</i></b>	For dogs over 14" and under 18" at the withers	45cm
<b><i>Standard:</i></b>	For dogs over 17" and under 20" at the withers	55cm
<b><i>Large:</i></b>	For dogs over 17" at the withers	65cm
<b>Micro/Standard height is optional.</b>		
<b>Veterans/Anysize can run Micro, Small or Medium</b>

#### Marking Rules

1. Maximum course time 60 seconds.
2. Up contacts will not be marked.
3. In Veteran/Anysize classes the Dog Walk and A-frame will be lowered and there will be no Seesaw or Weaves. Results will be split into separate classes but dogs will compete together
4. Training is permitted in the ring but your run will be classed as NFC
5. In starters classes a silent toy may be carried (no squeak or food inside) may be carried in the ring during competition (***The toy must be kept in your hand and can only be given to the dog once the course has been completed. Please do not throw the toy over the finish jump***)
6. Both rings will be surrounded by netting or permanent fencing

### ***Rosettes:***

Will be awarded in all classes minimum of 1<sup>st</sup> to 3<sup>rd</sup>, heights will be split when entries permit.

### ***Trophies:***

Will be award to a minimum of 1<sup>st</sup> place

## **Rules**

1. All competitors enter at their own risk.
2. Dogs must be over 18 calendar months to compete
3. We reserve the right to ask for confirmation of dog measurement. We accept KC measurements and UKA measurements.
4. We reserve the right to refuse entries.

5. The show is limited to 100 dogs plus judges and members dogs
6. We reserve the right to combine/split classes depending on entries.
7. All competitors when entering the show agree to help with ring party duties as enables us to keep the show running smoothly.
8. Anybody caught harsh handling their dog whilst at the show will be asked to leave.
9. Dogs must be kept under control, and on a lead, except when competing or within the exercise area.
10. Dogs must not wear any type of slip, half slip collar or lead whilst competing. A flat close fitting leather or webbing collar is permitted. No tags please.
11. No food to be taken into the rings either in your hand or pocket.
12. When queuing please leave a sensible distance from other handlers/dogs and leave the entrance and exits clear at all times.
13. It is the competitor's responsibility to be available for their classes on time.
14. Entry fees will not be refunded after the closing date.
15. If the show has to be cancelled, we reserve the right to deduct unrecoverable expenses incurred before returning entry fees.
16. Anyone found not picking up after their dogs will be asked to leave the venue.
17. Any dog that has been exposed to any infectious diseases or contagious disease during the 21 days leading up to the show must not be brought within the show boundaries.
18. Bitches in season must not be brought within the show boundaries.
19. The Judges decision is final.
20. Judges may run their own dogs
