## Terms and Conditions

All mares are to be wormed within 6 weeks of arriving at the Stud.

All mares are to arrive with a negative CEM swab certificate. Failure to provide one may result in your mare being refused admission to the Stud.

All mares must arrive with their passports. Failure to provide the correct passport for the mare WILL result in the mare being refused admission to the Stud.

All mares are to arrive with their hind shoes removed. Our farrier will be called when required and the owner be charged accordingly. Mares arriving with their hind shoes on will be stabled until they have been removed and the owner charged accordingly.

Veterinary attention will be called when necessary and all vet bills will be charged directly to the owner.

All mares will be scanned to determine their Oestrus cycle before insemination. This is carried out by the veterinary surgeon and will be charged directly to the owner.

All insemination will be carried out by a BEVA Approved AI Technician.

We advise that mares stay until at least 28 days post insemination for a heartbeat scan. Owners may remove their mare before this time, but it then becomes the owner's responsibility to have the mare scanned at home.

It is the Stud's policy to keep mares in a herd environment. Any mare that is seen to be excessively violent towards the other mares may be either stabled or turned out individually (if available) for the duration of their stay and the owner will be charged accordingly.

Whilst every care and attention is taken to look after the mare, no responsibility can be taken for accidents or illnesses that may occur during her stay or during any procedure.

All fees including Stud and Keep fees must be paid for in full before the mare (and foal) can leave the Stud.

The Stud must be notified by 1 Oct of the same covering year that the mare is not in foal, to take advantage of the NFFR Policy. This must be accompanied by a Negative Pregnancy Certificate issued by a Veterinary Surgeon.

The Stud reserves the right to stable and give the mare (and foal) extra hay and/or feed at the owners expense, if deemed necessary for the welfare of the mare (and foal).

Fishers Hill Stud reserves the right to refuse any mare or ask a mare to leave the premises that is deemed to be a danger to other horses or our staff.
