

## CAS UKMON Report to CAS Committee Meeting 12/07/2018

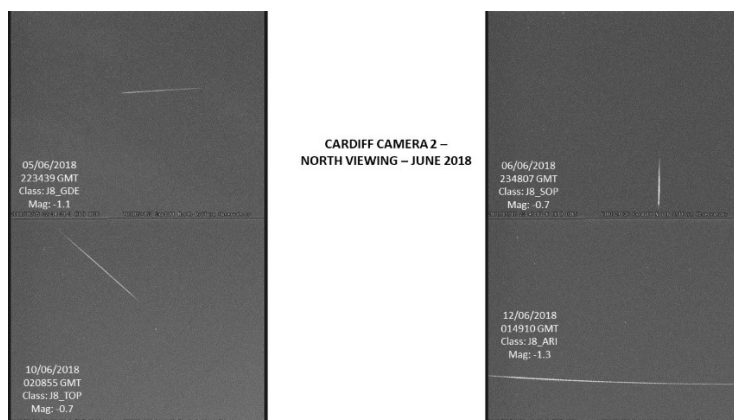
This report covers activities between the 17<sup>th</sup> May 2018 and the 10<sup>th</sup> July 2018 of the CAS Meteor Observation Camera 2 located as part of the Society Observatory at National Trust Dyffryn Gardens.

Camera 2 captured 31 meteor trails in May 2018 and 22 meteor trails in June 2018; no fireball events were recorded in May or June.

The CAS website CAS\_UKMON entry has been updated to the end of June 2018 for Camera 1, end June 2018 for Camera 2 and today for this report and general information.

The UKMON central database has been updated to the end of June 2018 for Camera 1 and the end of June 2018 for Camera 2. Data for July is still being collected.
