Drugs and Alcohol

Policy statement

We comply with Safeguarding and Welfare Requirements of the EYFS 2017 making our setting a no alcohol and no drugs environment - both indoor and outdoor. If Staff require medication JPAC Ltd must be satisfied that this does not inhibit their ability to care for the children in their care.

“Providers must ensure that those practitioners only work directly with children if medical advice confirms that the medication is unlikely to impair that staff member’s ability to look after children properly. Staff medication on the premises must be securely stored, and out of reach of children, at all times. “

Procedures

- All staff, parents and volunteers are made aware of our **Zero Tolerance** policy.
- The Zero Tolerance policy is stated in our information for parents.
- Staff who drink alcohol do not do so during working hours.
- The **only drugs** allowed on the premises are those which are required by staff or children for necessary medicinal purposes e.g. inhalers for asthma . All such medication is to be kept out of reach of all children.
