- 23/9: All about me

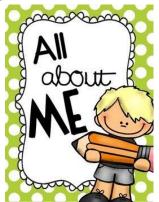
- 30/9: Space week

October half term Playscheme

You can start making your bookings from week commencing 23rd September. Playscheme prices are increasing to £24 per day and £26 for late booking or late payments to Playscheme. Please see our website for details.

Our operational times / plans

Please see below our basic overview of how the club runs, and times during sessions

Breakfast Club - 7:30 start time

- 7:30 to 8:25, free play including team hall games and crafts.
- Children are taken down to the Studio for breakfast at 7:45, 8, 8:15 and last breakfast run is at 8:25
- 8:25 Our pack away time
- 8:30 Register
- 8:40 Children are taken to class

After School Club - 15:15 start time

- 15:15 Collect Reception, Y1, Y2, Y3 and Y4. Y5 and Y6 come to the hall from class.
- 15:15 to 15:25 Children sign in and help with the set up of the hall.
- 15:25 Free play inside the hall
- 15:45 Snack time (first group)
- 16:10 Children back inside the hall, free play, craft table open.
- 16:15 to 16:25 Collect children from School clubs and take to Studio for snack.
- 16:25 Playground open for children
- 17:30 Tidy up areas. On Thursdays, pack away and move equipment to small hall
- 17:40 Studio closes
- 18:00 Club closed

During after school times, children on certain days will have access to the trim trail and outside play areas earlier where possible.

Superkids snack menus and snack plans

In the first week of July, we received our unannounced environment health inspector from Bromley. I am happy to report we now have our food hygiene rating, please see below. The team and I will continue to provide the high standards required when handling and serving foods. With this in mind and now having a larger number of children we provide snacks for, we will be changing the way we serve hot snacks to children.

From September, children who are attending an after-school activity will receive a cold snack once we collect them. This may include ham/chicken wraps, sandwich or roll. As this is the children's club, I will be consulting the children who join us after 16:25 and we shall see what other healthy snacks we can provide.

Finally, to comply with the food standards agency's conditions on after school care providers like Superkids, we will no longer offer sausage rolls (a treat snack) or breadsticks. Crackers will only be served to Monday's children who do not like Monday's snack.

Safeguarding Children

All Superkids staff, parents and visitors have a duty of care towards children we provide care for. Over the course of the year, I will be putting simple and easy things parents can do to help us provide a safe environment for the children.

For example, parents, visitors or children are not permitted to have devices that can record or take pictures. Therefore, the team will ask you to put your mobile phone away, even if your phone is in your hand and not in use. Staff, including myself, are not permitted to carry their personal mobiles without the consent of the proprietor (Jo Murray) or manager (Matt) of the setting. Superkids St. Mary's Club have two work phones, usually found on the parent desk, in my pocket or the person answering the door.

So please keep your mobile phones in your pocket, car or bag. Thank you. I will also put parts of our policy inside future newsletters and bulletins.

If your child is due to attend Superkids and they are sick, absent from school, an appointment, play date or for any other reason and will not be attending their set day with us at the after-school club: Please pop in and let us know or text us, we will be **very grateful**.

If you are running late, please text us or call us so we can let your child know.



A few things to look out for:

We will be updating our medical, dietary and allergy processes to a photo card system instead of a list of names. Over the course of the coming weeks, we will ask for a photo of your child. To save time, you can also email me a photo of your child. I do need this to be 'a passport like' photo (smiles are fine).

We also want to reduce the amount of paperwork stored at club as our lockable cupboard is getting rather full. Which is why we will be scanning everything onto the club laptop. Our archives / backups will be stored at the Superkids office.

If you have emailed a completed registration form to Jo in the past, I kindly ask that you forward this to me. This will save us time scanning your registration form, thank you.

Year 5 and 6 Room
