## "Asset management has never been more important"

We spoke to Nuveen Real Estate about the challenges that they have faced over the past 12 months and how the pandemic has changed the corporate real estate market.

When working with your clients in such challenging times, what would you say are the top three things that your team are focused on and imperative to do, to support your clients?

Firstly, communication, whether that is with clients, major stakeholders (including JV partners and operators) or tenants.

We have worked exceptionally hard to effectively communicate throughout the pandemic to ensure there were no surprises. This helped us to provide clients with confidence that we're doing everything possible to manage each strategy and make the best decisions for our clients.

Asset management has also never been more important. Our main priority has been working to preserve income for our clients through agreeing lease re-gears and new lettings, whilst also continuing to evaluate each asset for repositioning strategies including change or intensification of use.

What are the lessons that Nuveen has learnt from this crisis and how has your business changed in the past 12 months?

Over the last year, the need for us to be more customer (tenant) focused in the asset management process has become even more important.

By being as close to the occupier as possible we can better understand how an asset needs to be positioned in order to fulfil their requirements, and in turn this can help to generate stronger returns for our clients.

As mentioned earlier, while the pandemic has accelerated the pace of change, Nuveen's top down investment thesis is adapted to help us understand what trends are cyclical and what trends are secular, i.e. what is temporary and what is permanent.

This, plus an occupier informed 'bottom up' approach dominates our thinking, and has become even more important with the pace of change in real estate accelerating.
