



MAPP number linking


To continue providing a robust verification process on the application of pesticides to crops and better auditing of your records in the future, we have changed the way that products in Gatekeeper are displayed and the way they link to the information held in the Sentinel database.

As you may know, a pesticide product can have a number of MAPP numbers throughout its lifetime. New MAPP numbers are often issued when crop approvals change or when a crop approval has expired and been replaced with a new one. Up to now, the most recent products were listed by name only, whereas older versions of the same product were listed with their name and the MAPP number in brackets. Following this Gatekeeper update, all pesticide products will be listed with their name and their MAPP number in brackets (as shown below in 'New View' example).

New View




N.B. MAPP numbers increase with every registration, so in the case of Afalon above, the lowest number is the oldest product whereas the highest number is the newest product.

The benefit of these changes is that your records will maintain their link to the specific MAPP numbered product in the Sentinel database for all auditing and verification purposes. If you are supplied with a product that has a new MAPP number, in order to ensure that your records are correct, you must add the new product (with the new MAPP number) to your stock list. Always check the product label and make sure that the pesticide with the correct MAPP number is recorded in your Jobs.


Site and Organisation Catalogue Managers will need to add new pesticide products, as required, to their catalogues as they become available.

New Dashboard Design/Function



The Gatekeeper Dashboard has been redesigned and given a new look. It now contains some new tiles alongside the existing Top Pesticides, Market Prices and Farmers Weekly News Feed. The new **Announcements** tile helps you to stay up-to-date with the very latest news, events and information from Farmplan. For example, in Announcements, we can let you know about product updates, give you information on forthcoming training events and show you some handy season hints and tips on the use of Gatekeeper.

The Dashboard is now delivered to all users. The data in the Top Pesticides data tile is analysed from the Gatekeeper aggregated data. If you did not permission your data to be aggregated, then nothing has changed, and your data is not included.

Removal of GK Mobile feature

The Gatekeeper Mobile product was built on the Windows Mobile 6 Operating System which was discontinued in Jan 2013. As the technology is now obsolete and the hardware is almost impossible to purchase this feature has been removed from the Gatekeeper Desktop product.
