

Year End Process

FINANCIAL YEAR END PURPOSE

The purpose of the financial year end routine is to:

Provide management information

✓ Cashflow

Produce reports for your accountant to prepare financial accounts

✓ Audit Reports for the year

Prepare books for the new financial year

- ✓ Carry forward all relevant heading codes
- ✓ Carry forward unreconciled bank entries

FINANCIAL YEAR END PROCEDURE

At the end of the financial year there are several steps to be followed

- ✓ Ensure all entries have been made
- ✓ Reconcile all bank accounts
- ✓ Take adequate backups
- ✓ Close old account periods (apart from period 13)
- ✓ Open the new financial year
- ✓ Adjust closing/opening balances using journals
- ✓ Print year-end reports
- ✓ Check Standing Orders and Templates

BACKING UP

Even though all previous years' information will still be available in future years, it is important to backup your data regularly. It would be advised to take a web backup before and after completing your financial year.
