China, the largest GHG emitter in the world, currently has seven pilot schemes, including an offset market. These seven markets combined cover 1.1 billion tonnes of CO₂ emissions per year. What is even more exciting is that China will commence its national carbon trading scheme in 2017, covering approximately 4 billion tonnes of emissions, making it the largest carbon market in the world.



