

2017 List of Grants

The following grants were awarded between May and October 2017. Due to the increase in demand, we now accept applications through the year.

1. All Hallows Catholic College £250

To support Latin training and mentoring from the University of Manchester for teachers of Latin at Key Stage 3.

2. Astrea Academy Trust £2,100

To support the introduction of Latin in 5 primary schools in the Sheffield area.

3. Basildon C.E. Primary School £150

To support a new Classics after school club.

4. Bishop Luffa School (In kind)

Support for Ancient Greek resources.

5. Bishop Thomas Grant Catholic Secondary School £5,594

A grant of £5,594 over two years (£2,787 per annum) to support the teaching costs of one cohort of 11 GCSE Ancient Greek students.
