## Arrival

The bootcamp starts on Monday. But it would be great if you could arrive on Saturday and join us for a full-day trip of Gran Canaria on Sunday.

You will touch down at the Grand Canaria Airport located 27 km south from Las Palmas.

## Getting to Las Palmas

The easiest way to get to your apartment is by taxi. It costs around €35 and takes more or less 30 minutes.

To get to the taxi rank, simply turn right after getting out of the airport building. The official airport taxis will be waiting for you there.

You can also take a bus (€3) that goes to Las Palmas (**Santa Catalina** bus stop). Tickets can be purchased from the bus driver. The journey takes around 45 minutes.

Bus schedule: First departure: 06:15 / Last three departures: 21:15 pm, 22:15 pm and 23:15 pm. From 06:15 to 20:15: two buses an hour (06:15, 06:45, 7:15, etc).







# Accommodation

Las Palmas has a lot of hotels and airbnb apartments to offer. When choosing your accommodation, bear in mind that you will be going back and forth between your place and Soppa de Azul, our co-working space, quite often during the day. That's why it's best to stay within a 10-minute walking distance from Soppa.

To put things in context, when you look at the map, on the left hand side you will see a 4 km long Las Canteras beach. It takes around 35-40 minutes to walk from one end to another.

We are all beginners, water is shallow and warm, and it's a lot of fun. And we will have great instructors!

**Don't forget your towel and swimming trunks** when leaving your apartments in the morning. **You will NOT have time to go back to your hotel.**

At 16:30, we will jump into taxis that will take us to the other side of the beach. At the surf school, you will get a wetsuit, a surf board and an instructor. The surf school has lockers but it's better to leave your valuables at home.

**Important: If you want to join surfing classes, you need to have an appropriate insurance that covers such sports activity.**
