

## Notice of site entrance move – Chalfont St Peter vent shaft site

### Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Works continue on the Chalfont St Peter vent shaft site, off Chesham Lane, which will include moving the site entrance further north by 80 metres to improve the sight line of vehicles entering and leaving; pump tests and vegetation clearance.

### Site access move

Works to move the access will start on Monday 18 February and last for four weeks. So this is done safely, temporary traffic lights will be in place. There will also be some vegetation clearance to create the new entrance.

From Wednesday 13 March to Friday 15 March Chesham Lane will be closed overnight from 9pm through to the following morning at 6am. This is to allow us to move road signs. There will be a diversion in place using the A413.

There will be a speed restriction of 30mph on Chesham Lane in this area throughout the four weeks of works.

These works are subject to local authority approval.

### Pump tests

These are taking place on site until spring to measure the water pressure of the aquifer.

### Duration of works

Monday 18 February to Friday 15 March 2019

Normal working hours will be Monday to Friday 8am to 6pm with Saturday working 8am to 1pm

Our contractors may also be on site for one hour before and after these times

### What to expect

Some additional traffic on local roads during the overnight diversion and possible noise from equipment

### What we will do

Manage any impacts, such as traffic and noise, with the aim of reducing them where we can and take care to respect the community and environment

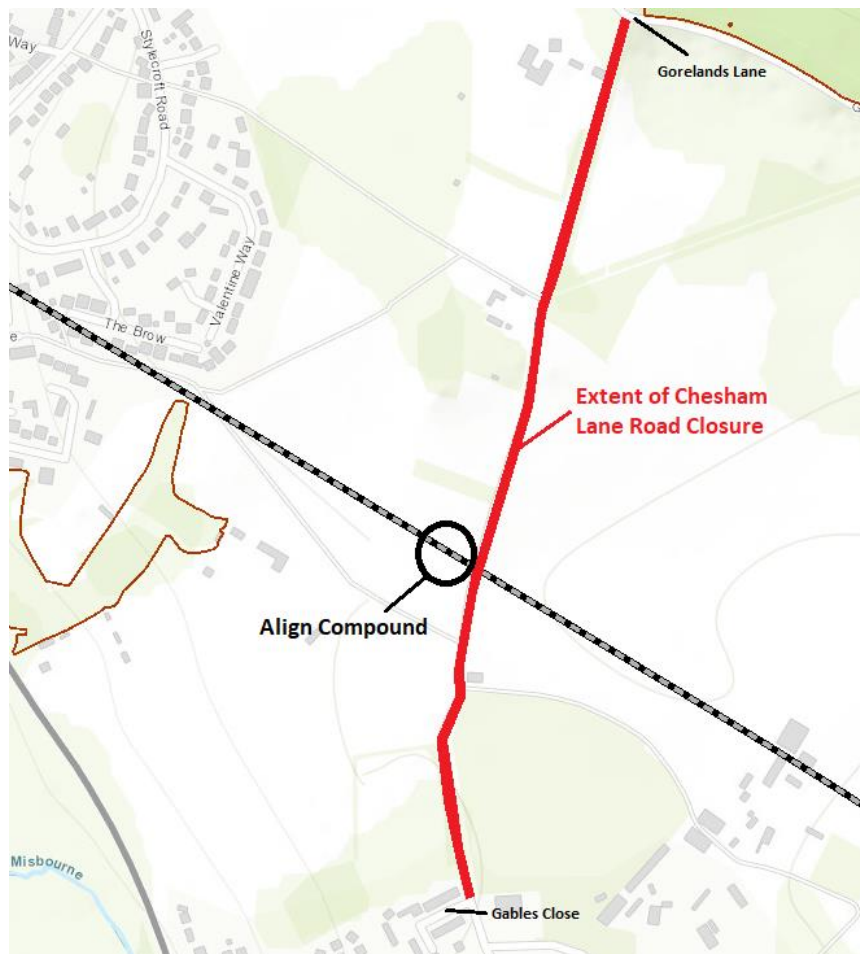
