





High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Regents Park Estate works

We are continuing the demolition works within the worksite at Regent's Park Estate. The Ainsdale building is now demolished to ground level with works continuing to remove the basement slab. We are also preparing to start demolition of the other buildings, shown in the image below. We will be installing scaffolding at Stalbridge House during night time Network Rail engineering hours on 17-18 and 24-25 August. Delivery vehicles will enter and leave the site via Granby Terrace Bridge.

The plan below shows the sequence of building demolition and dates are shown in the panel on the right.



Parking bays will be permanently suspended at the north end of Harrington Street. This is to allow access to the area of the site at the north side of Silverdale from the direction of Granby Terrace Bridge.

Demolition dates and durations

- 1. Ainsdale will be completed during August
- 2. Old Tenant's Hall from August for four weeks
- 3. Eskdale September for eight weeks
- 4. Silverdale From September for 12 weeks
- 5. Granby House From early September for eight weeks
- 6. Stalbridge From late September for eight weeks



Regent's Park Estate demolition methods

The taller buildings, Eskdale and Silverdale will be demolished using a long reach muncher and a crane which will hang a protective screen in front of the works to prevent material from escaping. See the illustration below.

This method reduces noise and because Eskdale and part of Silverdale will not be scaffolded, reduces the number of vehicles travelling to and from the site. Silverdale will be scaffolded on the wing closest to Coniston due to the proximity of the demolition.

Dust suppression is a priority and we have several methods in place to ensure dust is being controlled effectively. At the source of the demolition, hoses are attached to the muncher and along the edge of the protective screen which will continually dampen down the buildings as demolition work takes place. There will also be several dust suppression machines at ground level and dust monitors around the site boundary to provide us with an early warning system should any dust escape.



For approximately four weeks, we will need to close the section of footpath and carriageway that is adjacent to Eskdale on Stanhope Street.

The western footpath will remain open for pedestrians and a diversion will be in place for traffic and cyclists via Augustus Street.


Granby Terrace Bridge

Granby Terrace Bridge will be extended towards Park Village East to accommodate the new High Speed rail lines. Between August and December, we will be carrying out preparatory works to enable demolition in late 2019, including scaffolding parts of the bridge, the removal of the road surface and parapet walls.

Drainage survey

In late August a drainage survey will be carried out to assess the condition and layout of the drainage systems between Harrington Street and Hampstead Road. The drains will be surveyed via the existing manholes around the perimeter of Cartmel and Coniston House.

The survey will be conducted with remote cameras and staff entering chambers and sewers. Some drains may need high pressure jetting to clear debris and blockages.


Stanhope Street utility diversion works

We have installed a number of new utility ducts in and around the Regent's Park Estate, with the remainder continuing along **Stanhope Street** between Varndell Street and Granby Terrace Bridge.

During these works we have encountered unforeseen obstructions beneath the road surface and some of the works have taken longer to complete than expected.

We may need to install some further utility ducts to the south of the Varndell/Stanhope Street junction in the future and will carry out a trial hole to inform the design of the ducts. During this work, which will take approximately two weeks, there will be no vehicle access to Robert Street via Stanhope Street from late August to early September. Traffic diversion signs will be in place with access to Stanhope Parade being maintained via Harrington Street and Mackworth Street during all phases of this work.

Stanhope Street utility diversion works (Continued)

Between **5 – 19** August, UKPN will be carrying out works in the footpath only between Augustus House and Cubitt Court.

Thames Water works update

Once the utility works that are currently taking place on Varndell Street have been completed, the Thames Water works on Robert Street will move to the east end of Robert Street between Hampstead Road and Stanhope Street. This section of the road will be closed with traffic diversions in place for approximately 16 weeks.

Works are progressing at our site in Redhill Street, with work progressing back toward Albany Street.

The site on Albany Street will be moving across the northern access to Park Village West from the 19 August. The access will be closed to vehicles but Pedestrian access will be available. Vehicle access will be maintained via the southern access to Park Village West. A map showing the progress with each site is available on the Utilities page on HS2inCamden.co.uk.
