
High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continuing preparatory works for HS2 in your area, this includes works in the Regents Park Estate and extension of the Granby Terrace Bridge to accommodate the new HS2 railway.

Regents Park Estate

From 7 February work will start to establish the site in preparation for the demolition of Eskdale House (1), Ainsdale House (2), Silverdale House (3), Granby House (4), Stalbridge House (5) and Old Tenants House (6) on Harrington Street.

Fencing panels will be installed along the boundary shown in orange in the map below. Some footpaths will be temporarily closed off during the work but we will stop work to facilitate the passage of pedestrians as needed.

The Hampstead Road open space will be permanently closed and access to Hampstead Road will be via Varndell Street. A new footpath will be built on the route shown in green below, and open in approximately four weeks.

Update on lorry routes

We are seeking to minimise the use of Harrington Street and Varndell Street for construction related traffic. Until July 2019 the majority of construction traffic relating to the demolition of the Dales buildings will use Granby Terrace Bridge. Discussions with Transport for London are ongoing regarding the proposed construction of a haul route directly onto Hampstead Road following demolition of Silverdale.

Works on Varndell Street

From 18 February until 15 March, the Varndell Street carriageway and south side footway between Stanhope Street and Hampstead Road will be closed. To maintain vehicle access to buildings and minimise parking suspensions the works will be carried in phases:

Between Stanhope Street and Harrington Street from 18 February to 1 March

Between Harrington Street and Hampstead Road from 4 to 15 March

The north side pedestrian footway will remain open. The entrance to the car park between Waterhead and Staveley buildings will be closed from 4 to 15 March with access available via Robert Street. Three parking bays will be suspended to support these works.

Works on Harrington Street

From 18 February until 27 February utility diversion works will take place in the junction of Harrington Street and Mackworth Street. The works will be carried out in the footway and road, one lane at a time. Both roads will remain open with traffic management in place. Eight parking bays will be suspended on Harrington Street.

From early March the works will re-start in the north side of Harrington Street for 2 weeks. An excavator will be positioned on site and will be in use for approximately 2 days. These works will potentially be noisier than usual, although use of the excavator will be intermittent and not continuous. We will erect acoustic screening panels to reduce noise and work as quickly as possible.

There will be no disruption to utility services because of the above works.

Thames Water works update

Thames Water have completed their works on the corner of Stanhope street and are now working in the road outside Kirkfell flats and Dick Collins Hall. In the week beginning 25 February they will be moving their works across to Kirkfell. Access will remain available from Hampstead Road but will be blocked from Albany Street. The two disabled parking bays outside the building will be suspended during the works.

Works at the former NTH site on Hampstead Road

Four cabins will be delivered to the former National Temperance Hospital (NTH) site on Hampstead Road during the evening of 18 February. To reduce disruption to traffic on Hampstead Road, the delivery and installation will take place from 5:00pm and continue into the evening. The work is planned to be completed by midnight.

A mobile crane will be placed in Cardington Street to lift each cabin into position as they arrive. Service connections will be made using hand tools to reduce noise. Some lighting will be in use but will be pointed away from neighbouring buildings.

In March a tower crane will be installed within the former NTH site to assist with the demolition of the Thistle Hotel building.

The crane will be delivered in sections outside of core working hours to reduce disruption to traffic. A mobile crane will be bought onto site to assist the construction of the tower crane which will take place over a weekend.

We apologise in advance for any inconvenice you may experience as a result of these works.

Closure of the pop-up garden on Hampstead Road

The pop-up garden, located on the corner of Hampstead Road and Cardington Street, has now closed as the site is now needed to support works. The garden opened in June 2018 and has been used to hosts a number of community events as well as serving as a public space.

The skips containing plants, barrel planters and seating will be distributed to several community and charitable groups within the local area.

The HS2 in Camden Information Centre remains open as usual.
