Notice of works on Hampstead Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. We are continuing preparatory works for HS2 in your area, this includes works in the Regents Park Estate and extension of the Granby Terrace Bridge to accommodate the new HS2 railway.

Utility diversions, hoarding installation and scaffolding removal on Hampstead Road

From now until early May, various construction activities will be carried out on Hampstead Road between Granby Terrace Bridge and the junction with Varndell Street. This will include utility diversions and disconnection works, hoarding erection along the Regent Park Estate site and scaffold removal along the UCL site.

To maintain traffic and pedestrians flow the works will be carried by stages with traffic management in place.

Stage 1: The southbound footpath and bus lane along the former UCL building is **closed until 8 March** for scaffolding removal and utilities disconnection works. Pedestrians are diverted to the footpath on the opposite side of the road.

Stage 2: From 9 to 15 March works will be carried out in the northbound carriageway in two locations between Varndell Street and Granby Terrace Bridge;

- The footpath and northbound bus lane between Cartmel building and Granby Terrace Bridge will be closed for hoarding installation. The bus stop will be temporary relocated to the south adjacent to Cartmel building while works are taking place. TFL will monitor the traffic flows and may suspend the bus stop for the duration of works should this be necessary.
- Utility diversions will take place in the northbound carriageway at the junction with Varndell Street including weekend working on 9 March from 8am to 5pm and 10 March from 9am to 4pm. A 3-way temporary traffic light system will be in place and the footpath will remain open.

Hampstead Road works ongoing to early May

Working hours:

Monday to Friday 8am – 6pm, Saturday 8am – 1pm

Contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shut-down

Utility diversions, hoarding installation and scaffolding removal on Hampstead Road (continued)

Stage 3: From 16 March to 5 April works will take place on both sides of Hampstead Road between Granby Terrace Bridge and Cardington Street. The footpaths and bus lanes on both sides of the road will be closed with a diverted pedestrian route provided in the closed northbound bus lane. The works on the southbound side will be carried out in three phases so that access to Amptill Estate and the passage to Barnby Street will always be maintained. During the third phase the pedestrian crossing adjacent to the UCL site on 140 Hampstead Road will be temporary closed, and bus stop W will be temporary relocated to the north, adjacent to Amptill Estate. Pedestrian access will be maintained on the northbound side.

- **From 16 to 30 March** the footpath between the Margarete Centre and the entrance to the former National Temperance Hospital site will be closed for hoarding re-alignment works. Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footpath.
- **From 18 to 23 March**, for two nights only we be replacing the anti-skid road surface in the junction with Cardington Street and opposite the Lindale building. A small team of workers will apply the anti-skid surface manually and it is not anticipated that this work will cause any disturbance to the area or traffic.

Stage 4: From 6 April to 3 May the southbound footpath adjacent to the UCL building will continue to be closed between Cardington Street and the pedestrian crossing for further scaffolding removal and utility diversion works.

This will include a lane closure from 24 to 28 April in the junction with Cardington Street and weekend works on the 27 April from 8am to 5pm and the 28 April from 9am to 4pm.

Pedestrians will be diverted to the opposite footpath. Traffic management signs will be in place.

What to expect

Temporary bus lane closures with pedestrian access maintained on the northbound side

Southbound bus stop temporary relocated adjacent to the Amptill Estate from late March to 5 April

Footpath between the Margarete Centre and the entrance to the former NTH site will be closed from 16 to 30 March

Anti-skid road surfacing works in the junction with Cardington Street and opposite the Lindale building, two nights only from 18 to 23 March between 9pm and 5am

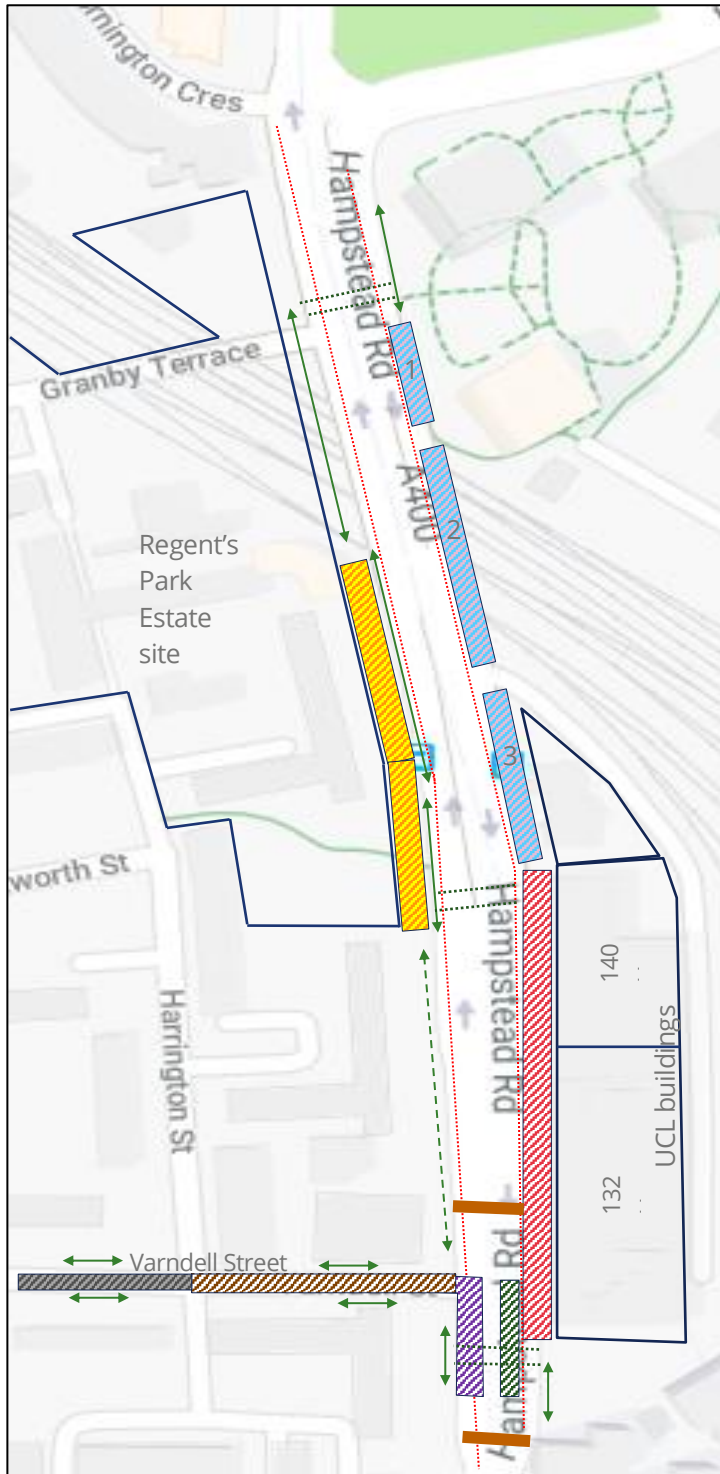
