UTILITY TRIAL HOLES

NORTH GOWER STREET / GOWER STREET

What are we doing?

As part of developing the route design of the HS2 high speed railway, we are carrying out utility trial hole surveys in **North Gower Street** and **Gower Street** during May.

The surveys will involve temporary holes being dug which will enable us to establish where utilities and services are located beneath the road surface. Please visit www.HS2inCamden.co.uk and sign up for news alerts for any updates or date changes.

How will this affect you?

From 10 to 22 May there will be two trial hole surveys carried out in the carriageway only on North Gower Street at the junction with Stevenson Way (E028), and on Gower Street next to the University College Hospital (E029). Please see the map below.

E028:

- The work will take place in one lane of the road at a time
- Temporary traffic lights will be in place
- Parking bays will be suspended opposite the Euston Square hotel, outside No. 162- 168 and No.185 including the disabled parking bay.

E029:

- The work will take place in one lane of the road at a time
- Parking bays will be suspended opposite the cycle hire station

Traffic management and diversion signs will be in place, the footpaths will remain open at all times during the works.

The initial breaking out of the road will be the noisiest activity, although this will be intermittent and not continuous. We will erect temporary screening clad with acoustic panels to reduce noise, working as quickly as possible and keep work areas tidy.

There will be no disruption to utility services because of these works. We recognise the disturbance this work can create and apologise in advance.

Duration of works

- North Gower Street & Gower Street from 10 to 22 May
- Working hours: Monday to Friday 8am-6pm
- Our contractors may also be on site for an hour before the start and/or at the end of each shift

What to expect

- Traffic management measures will be in place
- The sites will be secured with construction fencing
- Acoustic panels will be used to reduce noise
- The footpaths will remain open at all times during the works
- One lane of the road will be open at all times during the works
