West of Euston Station and Interim Taxi Rank update

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Costain Skanska Joint Venture is continuing preparatory works on behalf of HS2 in the area around Euston Station, including works required before buildings can be demolised.

West of Euston Station and Euston Square Gardens

From the 10 October, UK Power Networks will start work to divert power supplies on the north section of Cobourg Street. Short trenches will be dug to lay pipeworks ducts for new underground cables. These works will take place in stages with traffic management in place, and some parking bay suspensions will be in place for short durations. There will be no disruption to power supplies as a result of these works. At the end of October these works will move on to the south section of Cobourg Street.

The new temporary taxi rank at the west side of Euston Square Gardens on the corner of Melton Street and Euston Road will be built and open to the public from the end of October. Melton Street will become access only for taxis from the Euston Road, and will be closed to other vehicle traffic.

Closure of part of Drummond Street

From 15 October the section of Drummond Street between the junction of Cobourg Street and Melton Street will permanently close to vehicle traffic.

Pedestrian access to the station will be available via the scaffold walkway alongside the Ibis Hotel.

The traffic flow on the section of Cobourg Street between Drummond Street and Euston Street will change direction. Vehicles using the remaining section of Drummond Street will be able to either turn left onto Cobourg Street to reach Starcross Street, or turn right onto Cobourg Street to reach Euston Street.

Duration of works

- From 10 October; utility diversions on Cobourg Street
- From 15 October; East section of Drummond Street (between Cobourg Street and Melton Street) will be permanently closed to vehicles
- From end October Melton Street will be access for taxis only from Euston Road and the interim taxi rank will open
- Normal working hours:
 Monday to Friday 8am 6pm, Saturdays 8am-1pm
- Staff may be on site for half an hour before the start and/or at the end of each shift

What to expect

- Temporary traffic signage
- Changed direction of traffic on south section of Cobourg Street
- Traffic Marshalls will be in place
