



NOTICE OF GROUND INVESTIGATION SURVEYS

MORNINGTON TERRACE AND MORNINGTON STREET

What are we doing?

As part of developing the route design of the HS2 high speed railway, we are carrying out utility trial hole surveys in **Mornington Terrace** and **Mornington Street** during **July** and **August**.

The surveys will involve temporary holes being dug which will enable us to establish where utilities and services are located beneath the road surface. Please visit www.HS2inCamden.co.uk and sign up for news alerts for any updates or date changes.

How will this affect you?

The trial holes will take place in stages across the entire width of the road, including footpaths, on Mornington Terrace and Mornington Street. Work will begin on all sites on **30 July**, with all of the work completed by **17 August**.

The following traffic management measures will be in place to allow Mornington Terrace and Mornington Street to remain open during the works:

- The works will take place across the width of one carriageway of the road at a time, including the footway with the opposite lane and footpath open to public use at all times during the works
- Parking bays on **Mornington Terrace and Mornington Street** will be suspended to ensure a safe working site is established.

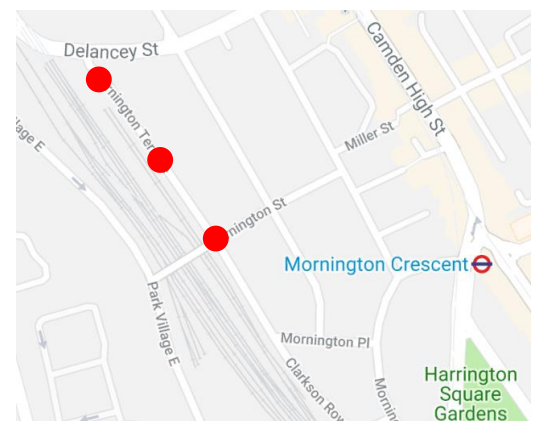
The initial breaking out of the road will be the noisiest activity, although this will be intermittent. We will erect temporary screening clad with acoustic panels to reduce noise, working as quickly as possible and keep work areas tidy. We recognise the disturbance this work can create and apologise in advance.

Duration of works

- Mornington Terrace from **26 July to 15 August** and Mornington Street from 27 July to **10 August**
- Working hours: 8am - 6pm, Monday to Friday
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown.

What to expect

- Traffic management measures will be in place
- Acoustic panels will be used to reduce noise
- Temporary parking bay suspensions will be in place
