

Your Thames Water update

We recently wrote to you to let you know about our work in your area to divert our water pipe in preparation for the construction of the new High Speed Railway.

Due to unexpected services being discovered we have encountered some engineering difficulties with our work along **Augustus Street** and **Cumberland Market**, this has resulted in a delay to our programme of work.

When we are working

Our first section of work on **Augustus Street** by the junction of **Cumberland Market** is now due to be complete by the end of September. We are sorry for the delay and thank you for your understanding.

We are soon to move further north on **Albany Street**, working at the northern entrance of **Redhill Street** (opposite Cumberland Place). This work will start on 28 May and is due to be completed early September. We are working in sections along **Albany Street** northwards towards **Gloucester Gate** until early 2019.

How you are affected

There will continue to be a road closure in place at the junction of **Augustus Street** and **Cumberland Market** and some restrictions to parking, please see on-street signage for parking suspensions and diversions.

There is a footpath closure on **Cumberland Market** outside the Medical Centre with a temporary path in place. The closure is expected to be in place until the end of September. Footpath access will always be maintained to and from properties.

The northern junction to **Redhill Street** will be closed for the duration of our work. Access via the southern junction will remain open. Street parking and residential access will not be affected.

Traffic diversion

There will continue to be temporary traffic lights on **Albany Street** to maintain two-way traffic. We will make sure our work does not prevent you from getting to and from your homes.

Duration of works

- Augustus Street by the junction of Cumberland Market due to be complete by the end of September
- Albany Street between Redhill Street and Gloucester Gate due to complete in early 2019

What to expect

- Closure of the junction of Augustus Street and Cumberland Market, & footpath closure on Cumberland Market outside the Medical Centre
- Some parking bays will be suspended
- Closure of the northern junction to Redhill Street
- Bus stop on Albany Street, near the junction with Redhill Street to be suspended. A temporary stop will likely be installed further north
- Working hours are 8am to 6pm, Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm on Saturdays.
 We may need to carry out essential work outside of these times and will notify you before we start
- Rolling, single-lane closure on Albany Street
