Dear resident,

I am writing to you in regard to the ground investigation works that are currently being undertaken on Herlwyn Avenue. In the previous correspondence that you received regarding these works it was noted that:

"It is expected that the work will finish on Saturday 28 October, however we may have to extend the work into Monday 30 October if we experience any unforeseen problems. If that happens we will let you know as soon as possible".

Unfortunately despite our best efforts, we are not going to be able to complete all of the works by Saturday 28 October and they are likely to extend into the following week for 1-2 days.

For the borehole that is located on Herlwyn Avenue that is closest to Roxburn Way (ML022-RC001 on the map below) we are anticipating that this work will be completed by **Friday 27 October**. While we expect that the drilling works will be completed on Friday, it is likely that reinstatement of the borehole and removal of equipment may extend into the afternoon of **Monday 30 October**.

For the borehole that is located on Herlwyn Avenue between Crossier Way and Westfield Way (ML022-RC002 on the map) we anticipate that this work will be completed by **Monday 30 October**. While we expect that the drilling works will be completed on Monday, there is a possibility that reinstatement of the borehole and removal of equipment may extend into the afternoon of **Tuesday 31 October**.

Traffic management will continue to be in place during the works, however, to ensure that we minimise disruption to Sacred Heart Catholic Primary School, works next week that require vehicle movements such as deliveries or removal of rigs will not be completed 30 minutes either side of the school run. Works of that nature will commence from 9:10 am and finish at 2:15pm, recommencing at 3.45pm.
