Breakspear Road South road closure postponed

We recently wrote to you to inform you of further site clearance works around the entrance of our Merck, Sharpe and Dhome site compound on Breakspear Road South which required a road closure. This work has now been postponed and the planned road closure will no longer happen on 15 April – 18 April. We are sorry for any inconvenience that may cause.

No changes to the planned road closure for vegetation clearance works on Harvil Road

Saturday 27 April - Sunday 28 April 2019, Harvil Road closure

The vegetation clearance around Harvil Road on Saturday 27 April and Sunday 28 April will still take place. This work requires a road closure on a section of Harvil Road to the areas to the north and south of the current Cadent Gas site on the east of Harvil Road. Ecological surveys have been undertaken and an ecologist will be on site for the duration of the works.





The planning and construction of HS2 is a huge operation – it is currently the largest infrastructure project in Europe.


