High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Works are required to complete the diversion of an Affinity water main. The nature of the works mean that it can only be carried out under a northbound lane closure of Breakspear Road South. The work involves excavation of the road. This will enable a connection between a new and existing water main that runs underneath the road.

Northbound lane closure

During the November closure of Breakspear Road South, a number of works were completed. However, Affinity Water were not able to provide the resources to complete these works due to an emergency elsewhere on their network. These works are now scheduled to be completed in early January 2019, and the single lane closure will be required for nine days.

The traffic management arrangement will consist of a lane closure with two-way temporary signal lights, on the northbound carriageway. The lights will be located outside the Merck Sharpe and Dhome site entrance to Farmers House.

24 hours, 7 days a week

To help against long term disruption and to reduce the length of the duration of the lane closure we have proposed to work 24 hours a day, seven days a week. During night time work all efforts will be made to minimise noise. Any noisy activities will be carried out during the day.
