



Notice of gas pipeline diversion works near Harvil Road, Harefield

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent need to move an existing gas pipeline near Harefield to facilitate HS2's construction, and to continue to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply to the area.

We have now finished construction of our new site access and our preparation works, and the new pipeline's construction will start at the beginning of April. We expect the work to be completed in November.

What are we doing?

The work to move the pipeline will include:

- Digging trenches for the new pipeline between the existing pipeline north of the Chiltern Mainline, to a point south of the Dogs Trust
- Installing a new pipeline between these two locations before covering them up again
- In some areas, we will also be using a method for tunnelling underground called Horizontal Directional Drilling.

There will be 24 hour security on site so we can maintain a safe working environment. Please note, there will be no staff accommodation on-site.

How will this affect you?

These works will not impact local gas supplies.

Most of our work will take place during our standard working hours. Where we need to carry out tunnelling, we may need to work 24 hours a day, but will aim to keep this to a minimum. This means you may notice people and equipment on-site during the night or early hours of the morning.

Temporary traffic lights will be used for brief periods to allow certain equipment delivery vehicles to enter the site safely.

Duration of work

April 2019 until November 2019

Our core working hours will be 8am to 6pm, Mondays to Fridays and 8am to 1pm Saturdays

(Tunnelling activity may be 24 hours for limited periods)

We will be on-site one hour either side of these times for set-up and close-down.

What to expect

- We may need to work 24 hours a day for limited periods while we carry out some tunnelling. We do not anticipate this work to be disruptive
- We'll continue to use our existing construction compound as our main site.
- 24 hour security on site.

What we will do

- Inform you as our work progresses
- Keep disruption from construction traffic to a minimum.

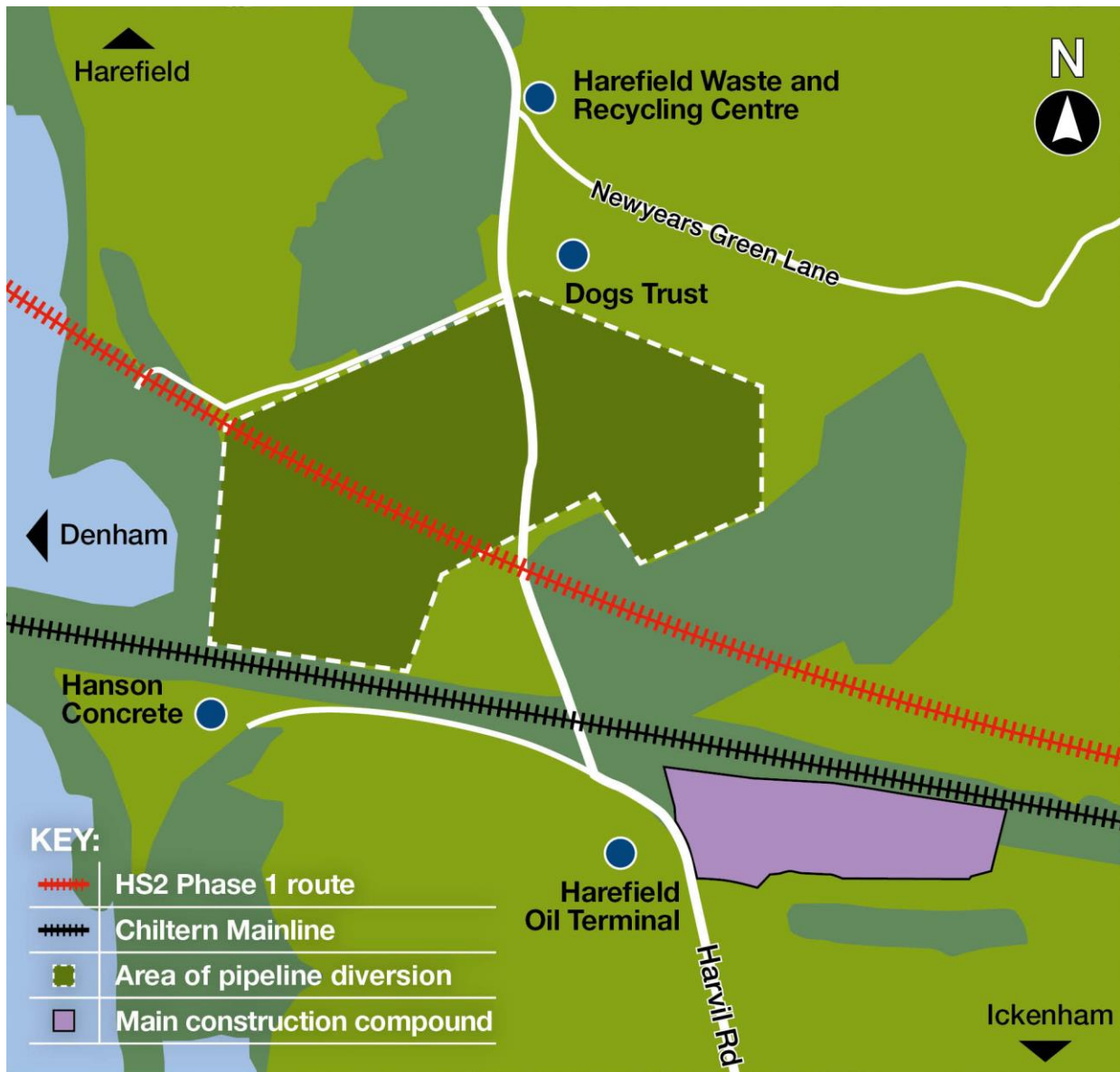
Notice of gas pipeline diversion works near Harvil Road, Harefield
