



NOTICE OF TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE

What are we doing?

As part of the preparation for the development of HS2, a temporary lane closure is due to take place on Breakspear Road South to support the set-up of a construction compound. The lane closure and site set-up works will be undertaken by our enabling works contractor CSJV on behalf of HS2.

The site set-up activities include, but are not limited to:

- CSJV are acquiring a vacant building, which sits opposite the access / egress gate of the MSD facility entrance, with handover due to take place from 8 January 2018. From this date herras fencing will be erected to secure the site. This will eventually become the site compound.
- A three week northbound lane closure on Breakspear Road South including traffic management will be required to support the installation of further site security hoarding around the site boundary. This is anticipated to commence in February / March 2018.
- Following on from this notice, we will send further information about what you should expect to see from February 2018 onwards, including the dates and duration of the temporary lane closure. - Temporary site access will be gained from Breakspear Road South. Between January and May, a new access / egress road will be constructed for MSD, which will be accessed from Breakspear Road South. This will allow the research facility employees to continue onto the MSD facility throughout the duration of the works. The road construction will require a second northbound lane closure to support the utility and survey connections. This is anticipated to commence in June 2018 with a duration of 6 weeks.

Duration of works

- Weekday working hours: 8:00 am to 6:00 pm Monday to Friday
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown.

What to expect

- The site will be securely fenced.
- The deconstruction of the private building and the construction of the new road will be the noisiest activity, although this will be intermittent. We will erect acoustic panels to reduce noise as much as possible.
- Trucks will only use prescribed driving routes.
- Traffic management (signs, traffic control lights) will be in place as appropriate.
- Public right of way to remain open throughout the duration of the enabling works.
- Shared access of the bridleway with MSD employees / visitors.
- 45-50 personnel on staff at peak times.


How will this affect me?
