Lane closure on Harvil Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As part of the construction, Fusion are continuing the preparatory works on behalf of HS2 Ltd within the Hillingdon area.

What will we be doing?

To enable the archaeological works that are planned to take place in the fields off of Harvil Road, Fusion will need to remove an earth mound and replace this with a steel gate which will allow access. To allow the removal of earth to take place safely temporary traffic lights will be put in place on Harvil Road on Wednesday 28 November for one night from 9pm until 6am (as shown on the map).

This work will be coordinated with the London Borough of Hillingdon and carried out only with the necessary consents.

How might this affect me?

For one evening Fusion will close one lane of Harvil Road in the red area shown on the map to allow workers to operate safety. The other lane will remain open to allow traffic to still continue in both directions.

Traffic lights will be set up to manage traffic flow with work starting at 9pm, finishing at 6am at the very latest.

We will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these works.

What else is happening?

For information, Align will be undertaking road surveys on Moorhall Road on 29 and 30 November between 9.30am and 3.30pm that will include a lane closure and traffic management. For further information please go to www.hs2inhillingdon.commonplace.is/


