

HARVIL ROAD UPDATE CREATION OF A NEW HABITAT SITE

What are we doing?

We provided information in December 2017 explaining about a new habitat site in Harvil Road that is being created. This is shown in blue on the map overleaf. The new site will be part of a number of wildlife habitats along the HS2 route.

How we are doing?

The site has been prepared with welfare facilities for staff and for machinery storage and onsite car parking. In addition:

- A new pond has been excavated and lining installed
- Trees have been planted which complement the area
- Reptile egg laying units are currently being prepared
- Upon completion work will start on ploughing and the planting of appropriate grass seed and new hedgerows.

How will this affect me?

There are a small number of contractor vehicles and lorry movements on local roads. Our contractor is closely monitoring any mud on the roads around the site and will take action to keep the roads clean. There will be several excavators and trucks working on site which will produce some noise. In addition to this there will be agricultural equipment used for landscaping the site.

Working hours

- Working hours Monday to Friday between 8am and 6pm
- Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start-up and shutdown outside of these times.
- Works are scheduled to finish mid-May 2018

What to expect

- During the works the site will be patrolled by security 24 hours a day seven days a week.
- A small number of contractor vehicles mainly on local roads.
 These vehicles will use only agreed routes.


What we will do

- Manage any environmental impacts, such as traffic and noise.
- Respond promptly to any complaints and take appropriate action.
- Inform you of any changes to the dates we have given you.
- Take care to respect your community and the environment.



How will this affect me? (Continued)

There will be a maximum of twelve workers on the site at the busiest times. There may also be additional personnel on site conducting safety and quality checks. Once the habitat is created it will be inspected and maintenance carried out when needed. All Public Rights of Way close to our works are kept open.





CADENT GAS MAINS DIVERSION

What are we doing?

Since August 2017, HS2 contractors have been undertaking works to prepare for diverting the 48" gas main at Harvil Road. More information can be found at the following web link:

Contractors are building a tunnel where the gas main will be laid which will run under the HS2 line. To build the shafts for the tunnel, Cadent Gas have had to amend their working hours.

How will this affect me?

The working hours will change to the following:

- Monday to Friday 7am until 7pm
- Saturday 7am until 7pm

Further additional hours will take place where contractors will work until 10pm due to the nature of the construction of the shaft walls as the concrete has to be poured continuously until each section is complete. Our contractors may also be on site for one hour's start up and shutdown outside these times.

These additional hours outside our core hours of midweek 8am until 6pm and Saturday 8am until 1pm is permitted due to its association of tunneling which will be carried out on a 24 hours a day, seven days a week basis.
