

Notice of lane closure on Moorhall Road

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As part of the preparation works for the construction of the Colne Valley Viaduct, Align, the main works contractor for both the viaduct and the Chiltern Tunnel, need to carry out land surveys to help develop the design for access to the construction site.

What is happening

Survey works using hand-held equipment.

To do this safely, one lane of Moorhall Road will need to be closed with the other remaining open, with two-way traffic lights. Works will not impact any public rights of way and access to properties will be maintained.

To facilitate these works we will need to suspend bus stops both east and westbound at the Bear on the Barge, between 9.30am and 3.30pm on 29 November.

Where it is happening

On Moorhall Road between the Bear in the Barge public house, up to where Moorhall Road becomes Moorfield Road.

Dates and times

Work and lane closure will take place between 9.30am and 3.30pm on Thursday 29 and Friday 30 November.

What else is happening

HS2's enabling works contractor, Fusion, are also carrying out works on Harvil Road on Wednesday 28 November for one night from 9pm to 6am, on Thursday 29 November. There will be a similar lane closure with traffic management in place.
