



### Notice of lane closure on Harvil Road to install fencing

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As part of the railway's construction we are continuing preparatory works within Hillingdon.

#### Lane closure on Harvil Road

We will be closing the southbound lane of Harvil Road to safely erect new fencing. The southbound lane (see map overleaf for exact location) will be closed every night between 9pm and 6am. The first closure will start at 9pm on Friday 16 August. The last closure will end at 6am on Saturday 31 August. A set of temporary traffic lights will be in place allowing traffic to flow in both directions during the lane closure. **Each** day between 6am and 9pm both lanes of the road will be open as usual.

We recognise lane closures affect both the traveling public and the local community and are therefore taking all possible steps to minimise disruption and inconvenience. We have planned this lane closure during night time hours when traffic is lighter. The lane closure on Harvil Road takes place during the second phase of the works at Breakspear Road South, when that road is open to traffic 24/7 around a lane closure.

#### Fencing installation

During the lane closure we will install temporary fencing along our site on Harvil Road. We will remove a section of the existing fencing on the southern side of the bridge over the Chiltern lines railway and replace it with a metal fence.

Due to the limited space available to our team to carry out this work safely, it is essential that we undertake this work using a lane closure. This will provide a safe area for our staff to work in.

Traffic will flow in both directions controlled by traffic lights.

Ensure the traffic management is lifted at 6am, every day.
