

Works update – Chipping Warden & Aston Le Walls

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. As part of HS2's construction work in your area we would like to update you on progress being made on the Chipping Warden relief road and Welsh Road junction in Aston Le Walls. We will be continuing to carry out activities around the area shown on the map below and will keep you updated as this work takes place.

What is happening in your area?

Following a short delay we have been carrying out a number of activities including surveys and soil sampling and are now in a position to continue the work for the new relief road. Fusion have appointed a new contractor, Buckingham Group Contracting Ltd, who will shortly be setting up and working on the welfare facilities on site.

Future work and traffic management measures

As the work progresses you will start to see more activities taking place including;

- Excavation of drainage ponds (as shown on the map highlighted in blue)
- Construction of the new highway (as shown on the map highlighted in yellow)
- Installation of new drainage and other associated highways equipment
- Diversion of existing underground and over ground utilities to enable the new highways to be built

To ensure our work can be undertaken safely traffic management will be in operation on the local road. There are a number of lane closures and temporary traffic lights planned from September 2019 to March 2020 on the A361, Appletree Rd and Welsh Rd. Traffic Management Measures (continued)

You may notice an increase in machinery in the area such as excavators and articulated dump trucks, JCB's and smaller dump trucks. This construction machinery will be operating during our normal working hours. Smaller vehicles carrying workers and tools will also be seen around the local areas as they go about their daily duties.

Archaeology Trial Trenching

We have also been carrying out further archaeological investigations in different locations in fields along the route of the relief road. These were similar to our previous archaeological works where we have dug trenches in fields and then refilled them. This work gives us a greater understanding of whether there is any unrecorded significant archaeology in the area.

How might this work affect me?

We will be working hard to ensure any impacts on residents are kept to a minimum during these and all our future works. You may notice a little extra traffic on the road immediately around the sites with workers moving to and from the site. There may be some noise from the machinery. All machinery will be restricted to running during normal working hours and occasional weekend working, with an hour either side to start up and shut down and receive deliveries as and when required.

During these works your utility services may be effected. You may be contacted directly by your utility providers to help keep you informed.

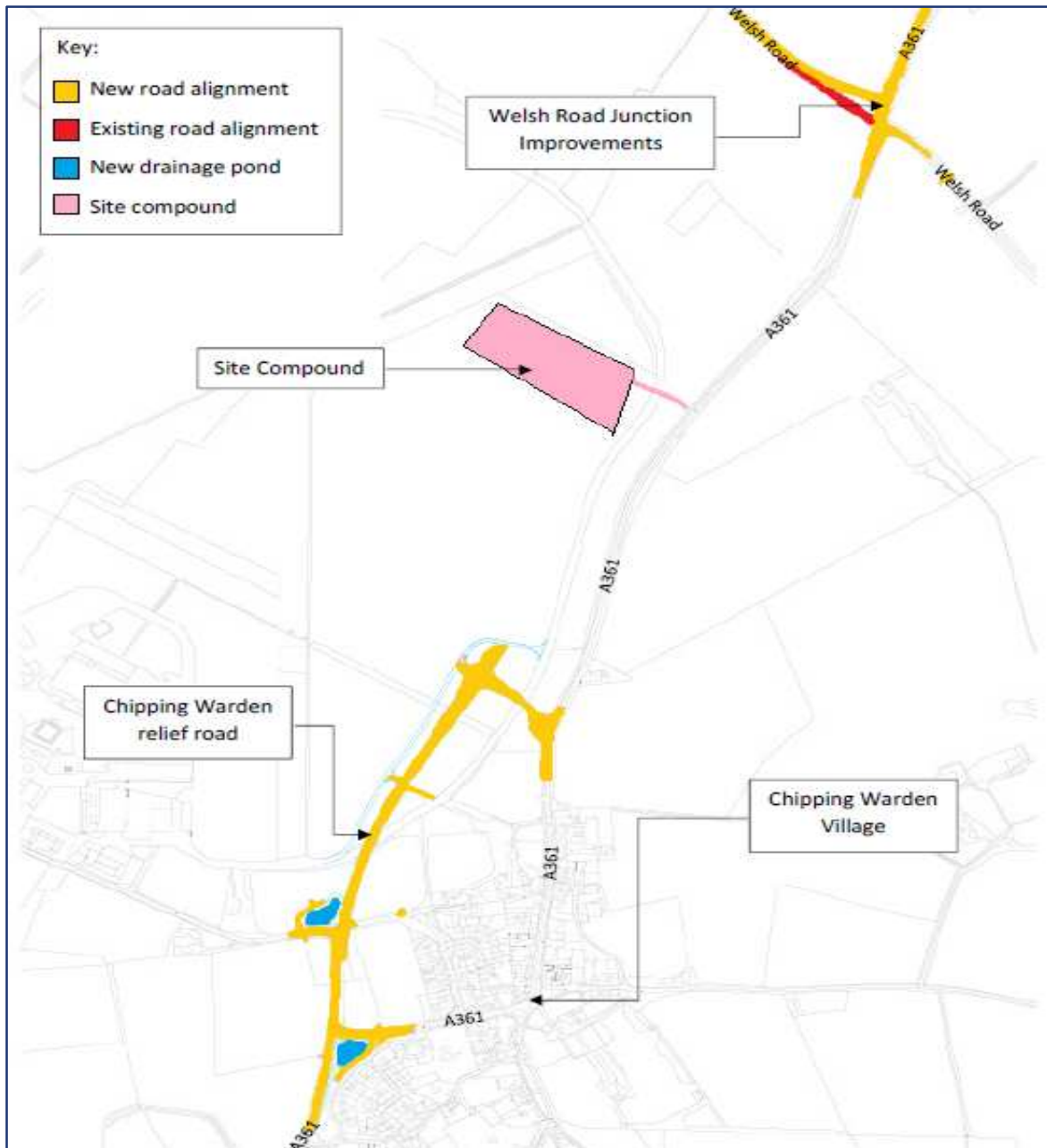
