



# Works planned during the festive period

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain.

Throughout the festive period the majority of HS2 worksites within the Old Oak Common area will be closing from 6pm on Friday 21 December 2018. They will then re-open at 8am on Wednesday 2 January 2019. There will be several days when critical work will be carried out on two of our sites.

## 21 December 2018 to 2 January 2019

**Atlas Road Site** – closed during this period.

**Victoria Road Site** – closed during this period.

**Great Western Railway Depot Site** – Works scheduled on the **27 December** until **28 December 2018**.

**Willesden Euroterminal** - Works scheduled on the **24 December** until **27 December 2018**.

## What to expect?

### Crane removal on Willesden Euroterminal (WET)

These works will take place on 24 December until 27 December 2018 between 8am and 6pm.

The gantry crane is scheduled to be disconnected from its moorings, lifted and moved to a new location within the site, in preparation for demolition in the new year. During the works we will monitor our working practices to ensure that all noise and dust is kept to a minimum.



## Duration of work

Monday 24 to Friday 28 of December 2018

Working Hours 8am to 6pm

We may also be on site for one hour's start up and shutdown before and after the above hours

## What to expect

Staff presence on site

Vehicle movement on site to facilitate the repositioning of the crane (WET)

Survey works will be contained within the carriage sheds (GWR Depot)

## What we will do

Inform you in advance of any changes to the dates and time shown.

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Ensure that all sites are reinstated to the required standard.




Please note that Network Rail contractors will be accessing the Willesden Euroterminal site to carry out work on their assets on the 24 December to 27 December 2018 between 11.30pm and 5am each day.

They will be undertaking work on sidings during this period.

### Survey works within the Great Western Railway Depot

The surveys will take place on Thursday 27 and Friday 28 December 2018 between the hours of 8am and 6pm.



These surveys are being undertaken to establish the condition of the sheds and identify any materials that need to be removed prior to demolition in the New Year.

During the surveys, hand held tools will be used to mitigate against any potential excess noise. The carriage shed will also provide an acoustic barrier.

We recognise that construction work can be disruptive to those living or working nearby and we appreciate your ongoing corporation during our works.
