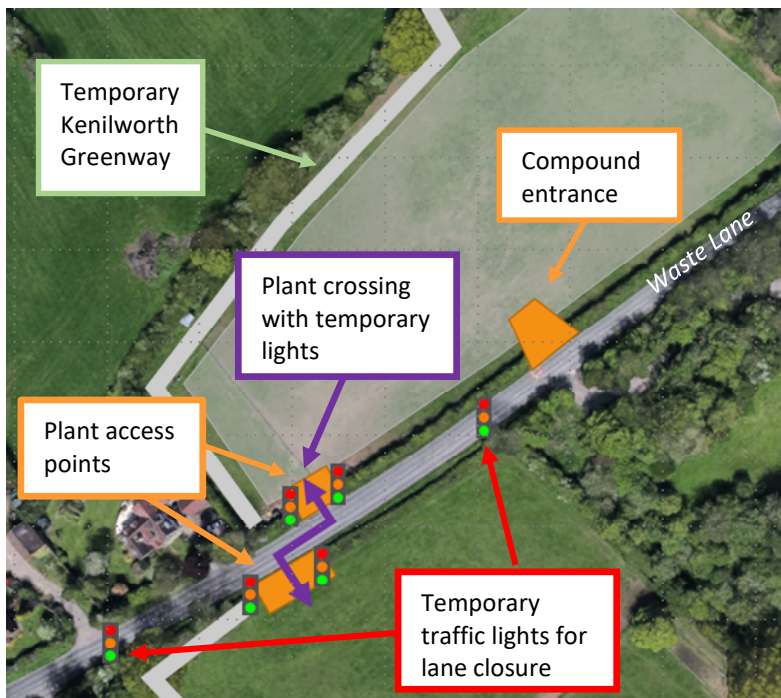

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

LM will be carrying out works on a section of Waste Lane, Balsall Common, from 30 September 2019 for up to three weeks to create two new access points for HS2 work sites, in preparation for the new Kenilworth Greenway diversion. This will involve lane closures and temporary lights to be erected on both the northbound and southbound carriage way at separate intervals.

Following these works, we will be installing a plant crossing for up to 12 months, to allow plant vehicles to safely cross the road between both access points whilst the Greenway is being built (see map below).

Duration of works

Two-way portable traffic lights on 24 hours a day from 30 Sept 2019 for up to three weeks, with daytime working hours on site between 8am and 6pm.

Plant crossing with temporary traffic signals from end of Sept 2019 for up to 12 months.

Our contractors may also be on site for up to one hour beforehand and after to set up and demobilise the site.

What to expect

Some noise from on-site machinery during working hours.

Maintained access for pedestrians, emergency services and to properties /businesses along the route.
