Notification



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent will need to move an underground gas pipeline to allow for the construction of the new railway. We will start work in February 2019 and we expect the diversion to be completed by December 2019.

What are we doing?

From mid-February to April we will be working to clear vegetation that needs to be removed so that we can carry out the pipeline diversion.

We will also be setting up a temporary works west of the A453 (Sutton Road) that will have 24-hour security.

We will be working to set up a new site access off the A453 (Sutton Road). This is to allow our vehicles to enter the site safely.

How will this impact you?

Setting up the new site access will involve a single-lane closure on the A453 (Sutton Road). This will take place between 9.30am and 3.30pm (Mon – Fri) and 9.30am – 1:00pm (Sat) for two weeks in February 2019.

We expect the Public Right of Way across the works site to remain open. However, if we need to close this as our work progresses, we'll make sure we let you know.

Our teams will be on site one hour before and one hour after the works to set up and secure the site at the end of the day. Our works schedule is subject to change depending on site and weather conditions, however we'll keep you informed of any adjustments.

As the work progresses we will send you notifications to let you know what will be happening.

Duration of works

From mid-February 2019 to April 2019

Working hours will be Monday to Friday, 9:30am to 3:30pm and 9:30am – 1:00 pm on Saturday.

What to expect

There will be temporary traffic management in the area.

Construction traffic will only use the A38/A5 to reach the A453 (Sutton Road) for site access.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

We will install temporary fencing to maintain a safe working environment.

Inform you in advance of any changes to these works.
