Notice of Construction work near A38, Streethay



High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM.

Construction works near A38, Streethay

Work is due to commence alongside the southbound A38 in Streethay, where we will be creating a haul road. Once built, this will allow works vehicles to enter and exit the southbound A38 from two new compounds, which will be constructed at this location for works on the HS2 project. Access to this site will initially be along Park Lane, where temporary traffic management will be in place during 8.00am to 6.00 pm. During these works, there will also be managed access to Ash Tree Lane as this crosses the work site. For further updates about the works please

Duration of works

Early March to December 2019

Working hours will be Monday to Saturday, 8:00am to 6:00pm with people on site one hour before and after those times

At times, we may be required to work on Saturday afternoons and Sundays subject to consent, to allow us to complete the work as quickly as possible.

What to expect

Some noise from onsite machinery during working hours.

There will be temporary traffic management on Park Lane.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Ensure all traffic management and diversions are clearly signed and marked.

Ensure that contractor's vehicles use agreed routes.
