


# Cryfield Grange Road - road closure

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high-speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM – a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be closing Cryfield Grange Road from Crackley Lane to Last Farm (indicated in red on the map below) from 23 September 2019 until January 2020. This will allow works to be carried out safely when clearing vegetation along the side of the road to create two access points into worksites for HS2, in preparation for further enabling works in the area. The road will be closed Monday - Friday, 9:30am to 3:30pm, with the road re-opening each day, once the site has been demobilised.

Access will be maintained for any households or businesses along the route. A clearly signed local diversion plan will be in place (indicated in yellow on the map below. Further information is available at www.hs2warwicks.co.uk.
