Notice of site set-up work in land north of Watton Lane

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent, who operate the gas distribution network in the area, will need to move underground gas pipelines to allow for the construction of the new railway.

To facilitate Cadent's pipeline diversion in the area, we need to carry out some preparation work in land immediately north of Watton Lane. This will include making the site ready for our main works and carrying out some trial trenching.

We will start this work on 26 March 2019 and expect them to last around 3 months.

What are we doing?

To prepare the site for our diversion, we will:

- Carry out some trial trenches, to ensure we understand the ground conditions.
- Clearing vegetation to make sure the site is ready for our main works.
- Erecting temporary fencing around the site, to ensure it is
- Putting up welfare facilities on the new site for our workers. Please note, these will not be used as accommodation.

We will use our existing temporary works compound at the former Old Salts Rugby Club site, south of Watton Lane, as our main site.

How will this affect you?

We don't expect our work to cause any disruption. You may see people working in the fields north of Watton Lane.

After we have completed these preparations, we will be carrying out our main construction work. We will keep you up to date as our work progresses.
