High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Cadent will need to move underground gas pipelines to allow for the construction of the new railway. To allow us to plan the movement of these pipelines and have a full understanding of local ground conditions, we will need to carry out surveys in the area. These surveys will take place over two weekends, including night working, in late April and early May.

What are we doing?

Cadent will carry out a diversion to an existing pipeline that runs north between the A46 and Dalehouse Lane. The pipeline supplies the local area and we need to carry out the work to ensure a safe and reliable gas supply continues during HS2's construction and ongoing operation.

Our surveys will take place in the A46 and include the drilling of boreholes and digging small pits, so we can take samples of the ground to analyse.

How will this impact you?

To carry out these surveys, we need to close the A46, except for a single, one-way lane open to traffic. The schedule is:

- 9pm on 26 April to 6am 29 April inclusive (a single, northbound only lane will be open during this period)
- 9pm on 3 May to 6am on 6 May inclusive (a single, southbound only lane will be open during this period)

Our works schedule is subject to change depending on site and weather conditions, however we'll keep you informed of any adjustments.

Duration of works

Weekend and night working will take place over two weekends:

- From 9pm on 26 April to 6am on 29 April inclusive.
- From 9pm on 3 May to 6am on 6 May inclusive.

What to expect

Closure of the A46 (both ways) throughout the works periods outlined above, except for a single carriageway (northbound only for the 26-29 April weekend; southbound only for the 3-6 May weekend). Diversions will be in place.

The A46 will be open as normal outside these times.

We may install signage on the roadside to maintain a safe working environment.

What we will do

Keep all sites safe and secure.

Inform you in advance of any changes to this work.
