

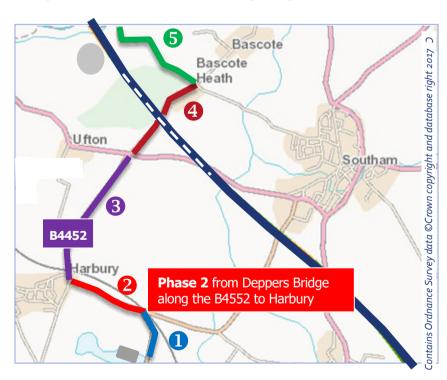
Long Itchington Wood tunnel utilities – phase 2

High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Initial works have now started and are carried out by LM - a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and J. Murphy & Sons.

We will be in your area to continue our works to install utilities from the electricity substation near Harbury to the Long Itchington wood tunnel north entrance.

The work is being carried out in 5 phases (see map below). The **second phase** starts on **17**th **June from Deppers Bridge along the B4552 to Harbury**. The road will be closed for up to 4 weeks. Access will be maintained for all households and businesses along the route. An agreed and clearly signed local diversion will be in place. **There will be no changes to school bus services during this phase of the works.**
