High Speed Two (HS2) is the new high speed railway for Britain. Early works for HS2 are carried out by a joint venture between Laing O'Rourke and Murphy & Sons known as LM.

Marsh Lane, Water Orton.

We will be carrying out ground investigation works in your area. These will consist of surveys to map the road layout and to understand the ground conditions for future junction improvements.

To minimise disruption for road users we will be carrying out these works on Saturday 7th September between the hours of 9pm and 6am.

Traffic management.

To ensure a safe working environment we will reduce Marsh Lane to one lane at the junction with Lichfield Road (see map below). There will also be temporary traffic lights in place of the permanent lights at this junction.
