IMPROVEMENTS

- **Core**
 - New End User License Agreement.
 - The “ALL_OBJECTS” dictionary view is now always used instead of “DBA_OBJECTS” when retrieving references and dependencies from a database, regardless of the state of the “Use DBA dictionary views if available” option.
- **Database Object Tree**
 - Added the ability to search for the object tree items.
- **Database Report Generation**
 - Optimized generation of database reports: When Observations are enabled and invalid object dependencies are disabled, ClearDB Documenter no longer fetches object references during report generation.
- **Generation Status and Log**
 - If a new report is generated into the file that is currently open in docuVIEWER, the user is now prompted to close it not to block generation.
- **Preferences**
 - “Preferences > Sessions”: Added the new option “Exclude users with no objects” to accelerated loading of the Database Object Tree. The option is disabled by default.

BUGS FIXED

- **Database Documentation**
 - Fixed invalid links on the Introduction page.
 - Fixed the title of the “DB & PL/SQL Observations” page shown after switching from another page.
 - Fixed the order of icons indicating users comments and attachments.
 - Removed the unfold icon for the parameters with one value.
- **Docu Comparison Report**
 - A comparison report no longer opens empty when the “Expand topmost nodes only” option is enabled.
 - The information about document sources is no longer shown on the Attachments tab.
- **Call Tree**
 - Fixed the pin/unpin icons in the Call Tree pop-up shown for datasets in a CRUD matrix.
- **Code Analyzer Options**
 - “Select All” now correctly works on the Generation and Classification panels of the Code Review Options page.
- **Online Support Desk**
 - Fixed the default cursor position.
