ClearDB Documenter 5.0.1 (build 418)

IMPROVEMENTS

- **Core**
 - At the first application launch, the user is now prompted to confirm collecting telemetry data. Selecting “I agree...” enables the “Let *ClearDB* Documenter send feature clicks to improve UI&UX” option. You can disable it later at “Options > Preferences > General”.
- **Docu**
 - The numbers of detected issues are now shown next to categories on the “Structure View” tab.
- **Output Documents**
 - The total number of occurrences is now shown at the bottom of the search results list.
- **Object List**
 - Optimized the filter input method.

BUGS FIXED

- **Docu**
 - Filtering the tree by “DB Status Valid” no longer removes objects from the DB & PL/SQL Observations section.
 - The “Parser: Objects with Flagged Code Metrics” page is no longer lost for objects with Code Review Alerts and Flagged Code Metrics.
 - Object statuses shown in the Object List no longer differ from those on the content pages.
 - Removed unnecessary links following to rules’ rationales on the “Structure View” page.
 - A footer is no longer shown in the “Legend” panel in the pages of Flowcharts and Call Trees.
- **Output Documents**
 - Files containing #%&= in their file names can now be opened in *docuVIEWER* and standard browsers without errors.
- **Database Security Audit Report**
 - In the Introduction section of a standalone security report, removed links following to sections that are not included in the report.
- **Code Review Rule Builder**
 - Fixed sorting of code review rules.
- **User Comments**
 - The “Comments” page is no longer empty when opened from CRUD matrices.
 - Fixed the UI elements of the comment editor.
- **GUI**
 - The “What’s New?” window no longer hides behind the main application window.
