INDEPENDENT AUDITOR'S REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL INFORMATION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF AL-SALBOOKH TRADING COMPANY K.S.C.P. AND ITS SUBSIDIARY

Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated statement of financial position of Al-Salbookh Trading Company K.S.C.P. ("the Parent Company") and its subsidiary (together referred to as "the Group") as at 31 March 2018 and the related interim condensed consolidated statements of income, comprehensive income, changes in equity and cash flows for the three month period then ended. Legal proceedings related to the lawsuit are in progress and the ultimate outcome of the matter cannot be presently determined. Our conclusion is not modified in respect of this matter.
