# REPORT ON REVIEW OF INTERIM CONDENSED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

TO THE SHAREHOLDER'S OF GULFA MINERAL WATER AND PROCESSING INDUSTRIES CO. P.L.C.

#### Introduction

We have reviewed the accompanying interim condensed consolidated financial statements of Gulfa Mineral Water and Processing Industries Co. P.L.C (the "Company") as at March 31, 2019 which comprised the interim condensed consolidated statement of financial position as at March 31, 2019, and the related interim condensed consolidated statement of comprehensive income, interim condensed statement of changes in equity and interim condensed statement of cash flows for the three months period then ended and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory notes. Management is responsible for the preparation and fair presentation of these interim condensed consolidated financial statements in accordance with International Accounting Standard IAS 34 as issued by International Accounting Standard Board (IASB). Our responsibility is to express a conclusion of these interim condensed consolidated financial statements based on our review.

#### Scope of review

We conducted our review in accordance with International Standards on Review Engagements 2410, "Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity." A review of financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with International Standards on Auditing. Consequently, it does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

#### Conclusion

Based on our review, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying interim condensed consolidated financial statements are not prepared, in all material respects, in accordance with IAS 34.

#### Other matters

The opening balances were audited by another auditor who expressed unqualified opinion and report date was March 7, 2019.

#### 1. Legal status and principal activities:

Gulfa Mineral Water and Processing Industries Co. P.L.C. (the "Company") was established in Ajman by an Emiri decree number 13 issued by His Highness the Ruler of Ajman on 28 March 1977 located on Gulfa Street, P.O. Box 929, Ajman, United Arab Emirates. The Company started its operations on 24 May 1977. The Company is a publicly listed company on the Dubai Financial Market since 17 April 2007.

As at 31 December 2017, The Company was 92.7 % effectively owned by subsidiary of Kuwait Food Company (American), a company incorporated in Kuwait (the "Parent Company"). The Ultimate parent of the company is Adaption AD Holdings SPC Ltd. A company incorporated in Dubai.

On November 2018, the Former parent company sold its entire directly and indirectly owned shares of various individual investors, accordingly the parent Company lost control of the Company as at the date thereof.

The principal activities of the Company are as follows.

- Importing
- Industry, bottles and plastic bottles
- Wholesale of juice trading
- Mineral water purification and bottling.
- Plastic covers manufacturing
- Natural fruit juice manufacturing
- Mineral water bottling.

#### 2. Summary of significant accounting policies:

#### Basis of preparation

- The interim condensed consolidated financial statements for the three months period ended 31 March 2019 have been prepared in accordance with IAS 34 "Interim Financial Reporting".
- The interim condensed consolidated financial statements do not include all the information and disclosures required in the annual financial statements, and should be read in conjunction with the Company's annual financial statements as at 31 December 2018.
- In additions, results for the three months period ended 31 March 2019 are not necessarily indicative of the results that may be expected for the financial year ending 31 December 2019.
- Items included in the financial information of the Company are measured and presented in United Arab Emirates "Dirham" (AED) which is the functional currency of the Company.

#### New standards, amendments and interpretations

#### **IFRS 16 Leases**

IFRS 16, published in January 2016 replaces the previous guidance in IAS 17 Leases. Under this revised guidance, leases will be brought onto companies' balance sheets, increasing the visibility of their assets and liabilities. It further removes the classification of leases as either operating leases or finance leases treating all leases as finance leases from the perspective of the lessee, thereby eliminating the requirement for a lease classification test. The revised guidance has an increased focus on who controls the asset and may change which contracts are leases. IFRS 16 is effective for annual periods beginning on or after 1 January 2019.

#### 9. Share capital:

The Company's authorised share capital is AED 40 million comprising of 40 million shares with nominal value of AED 1 each as at 31 December 2018. The issued and fully paid up capital is AED 30 million comprising of 20 million shares with nominal value of AED 1 each, all shares are were paid in cash.

#### 10. Legal reserve:

As required by the Company law of United Arab Emirates, 10 % of the profit for the year is to be transferred to a legal reserve up to 50 % of the share capital.

The shareholders may resolve to discontinue such annual transfers as reserve equals one half of the share capital. These reserve is not available for distribution.

#### 11. Voluntary reserve:

In compliance with the Company articles of association, the Board of Directors determine a percentage of net profit to be transferred to the voluntary reserve. The transfer may be stopped by a resolution adopted by the ordinary of the Company as recommended by the Board of Directors. There are no restrictions on distributions from the voluntary reserve.
