Selected Ports & Fortified Wines

The ports and fortifieds listed below are held in ideal conditions either in Davy's Victorian cellars in Greenwich, or in the medieval cellar downstairs. It was at this address from 1805 that the House of Sandeman set up their London home, shipping 'pipes' of port to London and rolling them through ancient tunnels from the Thames to these cellars.

Vintage port was bottled two years after the harvest before being distributed worldwide. The last vintage bottled downstairs was the famous Sandeman 1955. (Bottled in 1957) The Tappit Hen is the name given to the rare bottling size holding 2.1 litres or three bottles, and we have some (empty!) 1955 Tappit Hens of Sandeman hanging over the upstairs bar.

These Tappit Hens lay undisturbed in Davy's cellars for some six decades and were consumed at the 50th anniversary of the Boot & Flogger in Southwark, opened 1965. The Davy family's roots in the wine trade date back to 1870 as merchants and shippers of wine and spirits and operators of wine houses and wine shops. We remain an independent family wine business. A top ruby style port is bottled after around four years in barrel and aged for a minimum of three years in bottle. It is loosely a vintage 'style' made to drink earlier. The date is the bottling year. It does throw a sediment hence the name.

MADEIRA

Named due the literal process of being madeirised lending that cooked note to the wine and making it impervious to oxidation. It also leads to wines that age for centuries. From dry (which is off dry) to the sweetest style you have by grape variety; Sercial, Verdelho, Bual and Malmsey. Alvada is a delicious blend of Bual and Malmsey.

SHERRY

One of the best value drinks around. The driest styles are Manzanilla and Fino made in the same way but Manzanilla is made in Sanlúcar de Barrameda closer to the sea. Pasada is a slightly richer older style of manzanilla. Typically, seven years old.

Amontillado is the result of allowing a fino or manzanilla to age in barrel beyond seven years becoming darker with more exposure to oxygen through the barrels. White meats, pâtés and cheeses are ideal combinations.

Oloroso is darker still and stronger. Very nutty and ideal with meats or strong cheese.

Very very old Oloroso is exactly that. This one has aged in our cellars for over 50 years. Lovely as a digestif, or with game or strong cheese.
