- In **Christ** alone: the **Mass** or the **Lord's Supper**?

 - Hugh **Latimer** (1487-1555) and Nicholas **Ridley** (1500-1555)

 - The Lord's Supper: a "**Passover**" meal (Mat.2; Ex.12)

1. "...this is my **blood**..." – a **sacrifice!** (28)

 2. "...of the (new) **covenant**..." - a **reconciliation!** (28)

 3. "...which is poured out **for** many..." – a **substitute!** (28)

 4. "...for the **forgiveness** of sins..." – a **satisfaction!** (28)

- ⇒ "**with you** in my father's kingdom" (29)
-
- ⇒ "**drink** from it all of you"!
