

ROMANS 8:31-39

LIVING UNDER LOCKDOWN 3 – NOTHING CAN SEPARATE US FROM THE LOVE OF GOD

- Britain is celebrating 75 years since Victory in Europe Day - 8th May 1945
- Christians are also celebrating Victory over sin day – Good Friday 33AD
- But...how can a loving God let us suffer like this?
 - a) Is heaven really coming? 8:18-27 says...yes this world is groaning for its glory
 - b) Why is God letting us suffer? 8:28-30 says...God's purpose for us in all things including suffering is for us to become more like Jesus the true image of God
 - c) Does God really still love us? 8:31-39 says...nothing can ever separate us from God's unbreakable love!

Challenge No. 1: If God is for us: who can possibly stand against us? (31)

Challenge No.2: If God has sacrificed his Son for us – why would he hold anything back? (32)

Challenge No.3: If God has justified us – how can anyone else accuse us? (33)

Challenge No.4: If Christ is interceding for us – how can anyone else condemn us? (34)

Challenge No.5: What problem or power could ever separate us from God's love in Christ? (35-39)

How do you know he loves you? Look at his hands!
