# **Covid-19 support and information for businesses in Scotland**

The Scottish and UK governments have announced a range of Covid-19 support measures, some of which we have highlighted below. #### **Recovery Loan Scheme**

The Recovery Loan Scheme (RLS) is available to support businesses affected by Covid-19 as they recover and grow following the pandemic. RLS will run until 31 December 2021, subject to review.

RLS supports a maximum facility size of up to £10m, with minimum facility sizes starting at £1,000 for invoice and asset finance and £25,001 for term loans and overdrafts. Find more information about RLS on the <a href="British Business Bank website">British Business Bank website</a>.

## Sick pay

If your business has fewer than 250 staff, you will be able to <u>reclaim Statutory Sick Pay</u> (SSP) for sickness absence due to Covid-19 on or before 30 September 2021. The refund will cover up to two weeks' SSP per eligible employee.

### Non-domestic rates relief

If you are struggling to pay your non-domestic rates bill you should contact your local council and ask them about your payment options. Retail, hospitality and leisure businesses will get rates relief until at least 31 March 2022. To find out more, visit <a href="mayer-mygov.scot">mygov.scot</a>

#### VAT

Businesses in the tourism and hospitality sectors were eligible for a reduced VAT rate of 5% until 30 September 2021. From 1 October 2021 to 31 March 2022, a rate of 12.5% will apply.
