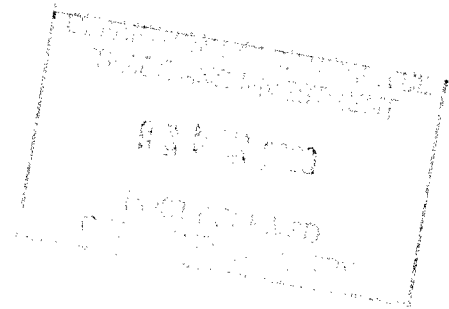


(1) ensuring that the company keeps accounting records which comply with Article 229, and


